Raising Awareness and Education

The walk route has been designed to visit places where communities and the environment are being affected by the nuclear industry. The walk will be leaving from London on the 26th of April, the Anniversary of the disaster at the Chernobyl nuclear power plant and will continue across France, which is the world's largest user of nuclear Power in the world.

We will finish in Geneva on July 16th, which is the anniversary of the first nuclear test, code named "Trinity"
